Pissarro would later exhibit in the Salon des Refusés, which was established for the many artists who were rejected by the official Salon. The Salon des Refusés also paved the way for the first Impressionist exhibition. In the early 1870s, Pissarro and his family were forced to relocate to London due to the Franco-Prussian War.
