There are two strategies for the surgical correction of JIA-induced dentofacial deformities: (1) TMJ preservation (i.e., orthognathic surgery, distraction osteogenesis (DO)), and (2) TMJ reconstruction (i.e., resection of the remaining condyle, synovial lining, and disc, and reconstruction with an autologous graft 18 or an alloplastic prosthesis 19).
